THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Section 12.G.6 of the APFA Policy Manual be revised to read:

The approval process shall be accomplished in a timely manner no longer than two (2) calendar days

from the date received. Should there be any questions or concerns about the content, the Base President submitting the base brief for approval should be contacted as soon as possible to discuss the concerns and submit revisions or edit, if necessary;

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Section 12.G.6 include,

a. If the base brief is of a time-sensitive nature affecting the operation of the base, or another serious situation affecting the base, the Base President will indicate that information on the request. The approval process shall be accomplished in no longer than twenty-four (24) hours. The Executive Committee members charged with the approval process as outlined in Section 12.G.4 of the APFA Policy Manual will work with the Base President to have the base brief approved as soon as possible to be sent to the members.
