WHEREAS, the APFA Board of Directors is the governing body of the Union; and

WHEREAS, the APFA Constitution vests in the Board the ability to set policy; and

WHEREAS, education and participation of the APFA Membership are imperative to the success of our entity; and

WHEREAS, holding contract and scheduling training in person at APFA Headquarters limits the number of people who can participate; and

WHEREAS, access to tools that enhance understanding of the Collective Bargaining Agreement can only benefit all Flight Attendants.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Directors shall authorize the creation of Web-Based Training to assist our Flight Attendants with gaining a working knowledge of our Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, these tools shall target different portions of the contract using the current information used for contract and scheduling education; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, these short modules will be under the development and supervision of up to two (2) APFA members in good standing who have extensive contract and scheduling experience;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Section 3.A of the APFA Policy Manual shall be amended to include a new paragraph 7 that reads as follows:

7. Web-based educational tools for Flight Attendants shall be made available through the APFA Website.
