Dear Laura:

This letter serves as a confirmation of the Company's receipt and acceptance of the APFA Combined Flight Attendant Seniority List (10/1/15) covering Legacy American Airlines (LAA) and Legacy US Airways (LUS) Flight Attendants. This list will be maintained by Flight Service in a spreadsheet format until the earlier of Flight Attendant Operation Integration (FOI) or until the necessary programming is completed to store the combined Flight Attendant list. As soon as practicable, the LAA adjusted Occupational Seniority date for each LAA Flight Attendant will be updated in the applicable AA systems. On a monthly basis the Company will provide APFA with any changes to the list and seek agreement as to the appropriate ordering in compliance with the language of the CBA. The System Seniority List shall be posted January and July of each year. This list will contain the name, Company ID number, seniority date, and crew base of each Flight Attendant. Flight Attendants will be subject to the protest period outlined in section 20.F of the 2014 Flight Attendant Agreement.

Seniority adjustments affecting LUS Flight Attendants will be consistent with the AFA 2013 Flight Attendant CBA and the 2014 APFA Collective Bargaining Agreement.
