## **ELECTION NOTICE**

Pursuant to Article VI, Section 2 of the APFA Constitution, WILLINGNESS-TO-SERVE notifications are now being accepted for the 2018 NATIONAL OFFICER re-run election, which is being conducted under the supervision of the Department of Labor. The open positions are NATIONAL PRESIDENT, NATIONAL VICE PRESIDENT, NATIONAL SECRETARY and NATIONAL TREASURER for the remainder of the terms of office that will end on March 31, 2020. A complete list of duties for National President, National Vice President, National Secretary and National Treasurer can be found in the APFA CONSTITUTION ARTICLE III. SEC. 6.

## **CANDIDATE INFORMATION**

This election is open to <u>all</u> members in good standing. Each candidate must be a member in good standing by **0900 CT**, **February 22**, **2018**. Any member in good standing may self-nominate her/himself or may nominate another member. Candidates **not** self-nominated will be contacted by the National Ballot Committee to confirm their Willingness-to-Serve. Withdrawals must be made within three (3) days after the Willingness-to-Serve due date.

#### **VOTER INFORMATION**

To be able to vote, each APFA member must be a member in good standing (no more than sixty (60) days in dues arrears) by **5pm CT on April 9, 2018**, and, in the event that a run-off election is necessary, **by 5pm CT on May 18, 2018**. A member will also be eligible to vote if he or she is on an official APFA payment plan that was executed at least thirty (30) days prior to the day that votes are counted, i.e., by **March 14, 2018**, and, in the event that a run-off election is necessary, by **April 23, 2018**.

### **ELECTION TIMETABLE**

Willingness-to-Serve Notifications must be received in the designated P.O. Box by **1000 CT, February 22, 2018.** The National Ballot Committee accepts no responsibility for the failure of the U.S. Postal Service to deliver Express Mail, Certified Mail, or proper notification thereof, to the P.O. Box. **Regular mail, posted in a timely fashion, is recommended.** 

Ballots will be mailed March 14, 2018. Ballots must be mailed and received by 1000 CT, April 13, 2018 in the designated P.O. Box. Ballots will be counted on April 13, 2018. If no candidate receives a majority (50% plus one) of the valid votes cast for a national office position, the National Ballot Committee will mail a run-off ballot to all members no later than April 23, 2018. Ballots for a run-off election would be due to be received by 1000 CT, May 23, 2018. Ballots in a run-off election would be counted on May 23, 2018.

The elected National Officers will assume office on **June 2**, **2018** if a run-off election is not necessary. If a run-off election is necessary for any position, all elected National Officers will assume office on **July 2**, **2018**.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR WILLINGNESS-TO-SERVE**

Only this form or a photocopy will be accepted. All information should be **typed** or **printed**. Each candidate's information will be reprinted in a candidate information sheet included in the ballot packet using a consistent format, and **no** graphics will be included.

All candidate information is optional, including personal statements and references. There will be no corrections made to spelling, punctuation, grammar, capitalization, intent or content. If limitations are exceeded, personal statements will be cut off at the limit and biographical information will be brought into compliance by deleting the oldest items. It is the responsibility of the candidate to inform references that their names will be printed in the ballot packet. As a reminder to all prospective candidates, the use of the APFA or the American Airlines logo, symbol or insignia on campaign material is prohibited.
