RE: Displacement/Priority Return

Dear Julie:

This letter will confirm our intent and understanding regarding Displacement/Priority Return, Section 22.H.4. of the 2014 AA/APFA Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement (JCBA). The following edits reflect the agreed upon changes to the language in the JCBA:

1. A Flight Attendant who has been displaced and subsequently voluntarily transfers to another crew base will not forfeit her/his ability to exercise a priority return. The JCBA language will be clarified as follows:

Section 22.H.4:

A Flight Attendant who wishes to exercise this option of returning to her/his former crew base must file the preference form within thirty (30) days of her/his displacement. Should the Flight Attendant decline the first opportunity to exercise a priority return, er subsequently transfer voluntarily to a crew base in another location, this right of return will be forfeited. Subsequent displacements or transfers will not cause the Flight Attendant to forfeit the right of return.

It is understood that the provisions of the 2014 AA/APFA Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement, except as specifically modified or excepted by this letter, shall apply in all respects.
