

COVID-19 TEAM MEMBER CONTACT TRACING TIPS

How do I determine if a team member or vendor/contractor employee may have been exposed? Carefully think through scenarios of how a team member with a confirmed case may have come in contact with other team members or vendor/contractor employees. Consider situations where team members or others may have been within six feet of each other for more than 10 minutes.

Here are some sample questions to ask the confirmed team member, depending on their role:

If the answer implies yes, then the exposed team member or vendor/contractor employee should be included on the respective Contact Tracing Form (the team member Contact Tracing Form or the vendor/contractor Contact Tracing Form).

- Did you stop and talk to a team member or vendor/contactor for more than 10 minutes while being within six feet of each other?
- > Did you have lunch or a take a break with other team members or vendors/contractors between [first date of symptoms-48 hours] and [last date worked]?
- Did you work an inbound/ outbound flight with any team members or vendors/contractors?
- Were you in the hangar working on a plane with other team members or vendors/contractors?
- Did you take the airport shuttle or carpool with any team members or vendors/contractors?
- Did you load baggage onto a plane with other team members or vendors/contractors?
- Did you have a meeting in a conference room with other team members or vendors/contractors?
