RE: Reserve Calling Out of Time Exception - June 2022

Dear Julie:

This letter will confirm our agreement regarding the reserve Flight Attendant maximum for the contractual month of June 2022 (June 2 – July 1). The Company will make a one-time exception to Section 12.L. of the 2014 AA/APFA Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement (JCBA) as follows:

- 1. In accordance with Section 10.D.13.d., the Company will flex the maximum line value for lineholder Flight Attendants by two (2) hours to ninety-two (92) hours for the contractual month of June 2022.
- 2. As an exception to Section 12.L., the reserve monthly maximum for the contractual month of June 2022 will remain at ninety (90) hours. A reserve will continue to be eligible to call out of time once he/she reaches at least eighty-five hours and one minute (85:01) for June 2022.

This agreement is non-precedent setting and non-referable. Also, it is understood that the provisions of the 2014 AA/APFA Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement, except as specifically modified or excepted by this letter, shall apply in all respects.
