This confirms our understanding and agreement regarding valet bag service for deadheading and commuting Flight Attendants. Effective May 11, 2015 in the event overhead bins are full, a deadheading Flight Attendant may have her/his bags checked – regardless of whether they are in uniform.

Additionally, a commuting Flight Attendant – <u>either in or out of uniform</u> – occupying the jumpseat may have her/his crew luggage valet checked in the event overhead bins are full.

Valet service is intended for the exclusive use of deadheading and commuting Flight Attendants. Flight Attendants traveling for personal reasons are not eligible for valet service.

Laura, I'm please we're able to offer these flexibilities (as in bold above) to our Flight Attendants on a trial basis and subject to modification. It is understood that the provisions of the AA/APFA Collective Bargaining Agreement, except as specifically modified by this letter, shall apply in all respects.
