## **RE: Clarification of Purser Position Move-Up Procedures**

## Dear Lori:

This letter will clarify the Flight Service procedures regarding Purser-designated sequences when the #1 position is not awarded to a Purser-qualified flight attendant during the normal open time process (e.g. PBS, TTS/UBL, ETB, ROTA/D). Time permitting, if the #1 flight attendant is not Purser-qualified, Flight Service will attempt to follow the procedures below:

- 1. If there is more than one Purser-qualified flight attendant on the sequence, Flight Service will contact\* the senior Purser on the sequence to ask if he/she would like to move to the Purser position.
- 2. If the senior Purser declines to move to the Purser position, Flight Service will offer the Purser position to other Purser-qualified flight attendants in seniority order.
- 3. If there is no voluntary move-up, the most junior Purser will be assigned the Purser position.
- \* If Flight Service is unable to contact the senior Purser prior to report as described in (#1 (above), Flight Service will assist with the move-up process at report time.

It is understood that the provisions of the 2014 AA/APFA Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement, except as specifically modified or excepted by this letter, shall apply in all respects.
